Of the six alternatives for management of the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge (ANWR) under consideration in the current Draft Comprehensive Conservation Plan (CCP) and Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), I write in support of Alternative A (No Action.)

I want to see ANWR open to oil exploration and production. Increasing American oil production would bring much needed jobs and help reduce dependency on foreign oil.
